You will have time on your own for lunch at Hudson Eats at Brookfield Place located near the 9/11 Memorial. Afterwards, we will visit the 9/11 Memorial and the Museum. View the Memorial's twin reflecting pools, each an acre in size, sitting within the footprints where the Twin Towers once stood. The self-guided tour is scheduled from 2:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. Please note that all passengers must check-in together at 1:30 p.m. Upon check-in, tickets will be distributed to the group. Everyone will need to go through airport-type security prior to entering the museum. Explore the museum's vast displays and artifacts associated with the events of 9/11, while presenting stories of loss and recovery. A free app is available for download on apple/android devices. If passengers decide to do this, they must have headsets/earbuds to use in the museum. It is suggested to download the app in advance to confirm it downloads properly and answers questions. The museum has headsets for rent, but renters must leave a photo ID to ensure the return of the device. Headsets cannot be reserved in advance. The bus will stop for coffee/meal breaks on the way to and from NYC. **(Considerable Walking)**
