9AM CEREMONIES TO START-OFF TRADITIONAL HONORS

The commemoration of Memorial Day in North Kingstown will begin at 9 AM, Monday, May 28 with wreath laying ceremonies at the Civil War Memorial on the grounds of the town hall at 80 Boston Neck Road (Rte. 1A) and at the memorials at the nearby Veterans Memorial Park.

The series of wreath laying ceremonies are so planned that those looking to take part will have sufficient time to ready for the parade start.

ANNUAL PARADE SLATED FOR 10 AM

Parade marchers will begin forming at 9 AM at Wilson Park and the parade will start at 10 AM. The parade route will follow West Main, Brown, and Phillips Streets through Wickford village and then onto Tower Hill Road (Rte. 1 south) to the Grand Army of the Republic Memorial on the grounds of Elm Grove Cemetery for the concluding ceremonies which are expected to start at 11 AM.
