ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 20 – 07

April 13, 2020

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2020, by virtue of the direction given by the North Kingstown Town Council under Section 2-168 of the Code of Ordinances, and in conjunction with R.I. General Laws 30-15-12, 30-15-13, 30-15-19, and others, I, A. Ralph Mollis, Town Manager, extended the declaration of a local State of Emergency for the Town of North Kingstown through April 30, 2020 due to the dangers to health and life posted by COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, said extension via Administrative Order 20 – 06 encompassed all restrictions listed within Administrative Order 20 – 02, as amended via Administrative Orders 20 – 04 and 20 – 05 as well as Administrative Orders 20 – 01 and 20 – 03; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 virus continues to be a danger to health & life and jeopardizes the health and well being of the residents of North Kingstown with said dangers extending to the operation of our Town's Transfer Station creating safety hazards due to traffic congestion, undue burden on the Town due to regretful abuse and large scale items and said congestion being a potential danger to health & life of both employees and residents utilizing the services of the Transfer Station.

NOW THEREFORE, effective April 11, 2020 and lasting through the duration of the local State of Emergency for the Town of North Kingstown, the following limitations will be put in effect in an effort to do all we can to protect our residents, our employees and families by limiting personal exposure and social interaction and being mindful of health and sanitation concerns for disposal of household trash:

- All customers entering the Transfer Station Facility will be required to provide Proof of Residency in one of the following forms:
 - Driver's License
 - Vehicle Registration
 - Tax Bill
 - Utility Bill

- All residential trash must be bagged and affixed with a valid North Kingstown Refuse Tag. No scaling of loads available for residential customers.
- No furniture, carpeting or any other household item not in a tagged bag will be accepted.
- No mattresses.

FURTHER, these restrictions are necessary to help keep our employees safe by limiting exposure to potential health hazards and keep our residents safe by limiting social interaction, maintaining social distancing and alleviating traffic congestion hazards. We thank you for your understanding and cooperation during these challenging times.

This Order is effective April 11, 2020 and will remain in full force and effect through the local Declaration of State of Emergency unless otherwise renewed, amended or terminated by a subsequent declaration.
