### **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 20 – 09**

**April 21, 2020**

**WHEREAS**, on April 20, 2020, by virtue of the direction given by the North Kingstown Town Council under Section 2-168 of the Code of Ordinances, and in conjunction with R.I. General Laws 30-15-12, 30-15-13, 30-15-19, and others, I, A. Ralph Mollis, Town Manager, extended the declaration of a local State of Emergency for the Town of North Kingstown through May 8, 2020 due to the dangers to health and life posted by COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, said extension via Administrative Order 20 – 08 encompassed all restrictions listed within previous Administrative Orders; and

**WHEREAS**, the effects of this COVID-19 Pandemic pose challenges and burdens to all our Town's taxpayers, including those who hold Mooring Permits.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in an effort to lessen the burden and challenges facing our residents and Mooring Permit Holders, the Town of North Kingstown is extending the due date for Mooring Fees through May 31, 2020 and are waiving all late fees through May 31<sup>st</sup>. Applications and payments will be due May 31, 2020. The previous \$100 late fee will apply to any payments made after May 31, 2020. As of July 1, 2020 any unpaid permit fees will result in a cancellation of the permit and mooring removed at the permittees expense.

**BE IT FURTHER DIRECTED**, that the North Kingstown Harbor Master is directed to relay this information to all applicable parties as well as Onlinemooring.com information which makes it easier for holders to renew their permits.

**This Order is effective April 21, 2020 and will remain in full force and effect unless otherwise amended or extended by a subsequent declaration. Per Order Of:**
