At the Regular Meeting of the Town Council of the Town of North Kingstown held on March 26, 2012, a resolution was passed as follows:

WHEREAS, streets constitute a large and valuable portion of the public space; and

WHEREAS, streets need to be accessible, convenient and connected corridors for all transportation modes and users that complement and support adjoining land uses, buildings and community character; and

WHEREAS, streets that integrate and invite multiple transportation choices contribute to the public life of a community, sustainable economic development and efficient movement of people and goods; and

WHEREAS, encouraging non-motorized transportation provides residents with mobility options, reduces transportation costs, enhances community connections, improves public health, advances environmental stewardship, reduces fuel consumption, and maximizes the use of roadway infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, "Complete Streets" are those that provide safe and convenient access for motorists as well as pedestrians, bicyclists, and transit riders of all ages and abilities; and

WHEREAS, "Complete Streets" concepts are compatible with the Circulation, Land Use, and Post Road Elements of the Town of North Kingstown Comprehensive Plan as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, WE THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NORTH KINGSTOWN do hereby indicate our support and encouragement of the use of "Complete Streets" concepts in the planning and redevelopment of transportation related infrastructure improvements within the Town of North Kingstown and the State of Rhode Island.
