The owner of the property located at _____, Plat _____ Lot _____, hereby makes application to connect said property with the public sewer. In consideration of the granting of this permit, the undersigned owner/contractor agrees to the following:

1. To strictly conform to all existing ordinances, rules and regulations relating to the use of the public sewers and the making and using of all connections with said sewer, which may hereafter be enacted by the Town Council or the Public Works Director and approved by the Town Council and all pertinent regulations required by the Quonset Development Corporation (QDC).
2. Significant Industrial Users, as defined by the QDC, must first obtain a permit per QDC Sewer Treatment System User Regulations and Industrial Pretreatment Standards.
3. That no claim for damages shall be made against the Town of North Kingstown.
4. The Town does not guarantee the existence and/or location of any sewer and/or connection.
5. That the Public Works Director or his duly authorized representative shall have access at all reasonable hours to the premises to see that all ordinances, rules and regulations relating to the public sewer and all connections therewith are being complied with.
6. All connections shall be of such size and material, and laid to such grade and depth as required in the ordinances, standard details, specifications, rules, and regulations relating to use of public sewers per the Town and QDC.
7. All work of making connections shall be under the supervision of the Public Works Director, or his duly authorized representative.
8. All excavation and repair work necessary or required shall conform to all ordinances, standard details, specifications, rules, and regulations pertaining to such right-of-way.
9. That plans and specifications for the proposed building sewer are to be attached hereto by the applicant.
10. The building sewer shall be maintained at no expense to the Town.
11. To notify the Public Works Department/ Engineering Office at least two (2) working days prior to the time the building sewer is ready for inspection and connection to the public sewer, but before any portion of the work is covered.
12. Return this form to the Engineering Office with the appropriate signature for the Public Works Director or his agent to certify the job has been inspected, and completed in accordance with the requirements of the ordinance with detailed as-built information.
13. Obtain the necessary permit(s) from the Engineering Office and/or RIDOT as applicable. Note that an excavation permit is required for any work in the Town right-of-way. DigSafe must also be notified.
14. To install a backwater valve prior to connection to the sewer lateral.
15. All expenses incurred with this project are the responsibility of the property owner.
16. All repair work to the public right-of-way necessitated by this excavation shall be the sole responsibility of the undersigned contractor. The contractor must be a Licensed Drainlayer in the Town of North Kingstown or a Licensed Master Plumber in the State of Rhode Island.
17. This connection permit shall only be good for 60 days from the date of issue.
